Realities for Children Boulder County is a nonprofit agency providing support to at-risk, abused and neglected youth in Boulder County. Executive Director Eric Schulz pointed out that because of the unique way his organization collaborates with the business community, 100% of all the donations from this event and other fundraising events go






directly to the kids. "We partner with local businesses offering them marketing and promotional packages in exchange for membership. We also partner with other charities. We're all about collaboration and community."


"I liked that we could decorate and we met new people because people sat in the space right next to us."
